Notes:

1. The first prefix letter indicates the printer: A, B for BAI (British-American International); E, F, G, H for CBN (Canadian Bank Note). The second letter is a denomination letter: \$5: A, B, C, N, O, P; \$10: D, E, F, G, T; \$20: I, L, R, S, U, V, W, Y, Z; \$50: H, M; \$100: J, K. The third letter indicates series. Letters I, O, Q, and X are not used.
2. M/C \$20 BIE-BIZ, BSA-BSW notes and M/C \$50 AHS-AHZ, AMA-AMK notes are the only two varieties printed by BAI, all other notes by CBN.
3. Green prefixes are first variety prefixes confirmed by the Bank of Canada.
4. Red prefixes are last variety prefixes confirmed by the Bank of Canada. Otherwise, the last prefix for each variety is simply the last known prefix.
5. M/C last prefixes \$10 FTH, \$20 BSW and \$50 AMK are very rare, only a few notes have been found in circulation for each prefix. None known in UNC.
