Letters I, O, Q, and X are not used.

- 3. Green prefixes are first variety prefixes confirmed by the Bank of Canada.
- 4. Red prefixes are last variety prefixes confirmed by the Bank of Canada. Otherwise, the last prefix for each variety is simply the last known prefix.
- 5. M/C last prefixes \$10 FTH, \$20 BSW and \$50 AMK are very rare, only a few notes have been found in circulation for each prefix. None known in UNC.
